VIII. Rights of the data subject

When processing personal data, you have the following rights regarding the protection of your personal data:

- the right to request access to your personal data from us;
- the right to correct your personal data that we process;
- the right to restrict processing. Processing restrictions mean that we need your to mark personal information that was limited and for the duration of the restriction we may not further process them except their storage. You have the right to restrict processing if:
- you deny the accuracy of your personal information for the time necessary to enable us to verify personal data;
- the processing is illegal and you refuse to delete the personal data and ask instead to limit their data use;

 - the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority, if you believe that the processing of personal data is a violation of legal regulations on personal data protection. You can file a complaint with the supervisory authority at the place of your residence, at the place of employment or at the place where the alleged infringement took place. IX. The right to object to the processing
